Exodus 15:22-27  
Hebrews 3:1-6

Today's Scripture Verse:    *Now Moses was faithful in all God's house as a servant, to testify to the things that would be spoken later. Christ, however, was faithful over God's house as a son, and we are his house if we hold firm the confidence and the pride that belong to hope. (Hebrews 3:5-6)*

What it means:                New Testament Scriptures often speak about Jesus as one who carries forth the hope and promise of Moses. In this passage, a distinction is made clearly between Moses as a servant of God and Jesus as God's faithful son. Verse 16 also talks about those who follow Christ as being God's house – so that the people of the church are the place where God dwells, as long as we live in hope.

Our time of reflection:      God, we pray that we may truly house the hopefulness of God. Let our actions be faithful, so that the world may see the Spirit of God dwelling in us and bringing hope to the world.
