Daily Lectionary Readings      Psalm 130  
Ezekiel 1:1-3; 2:8-3:3  
Revelation 10:1-11:

Today's Scripture Verse:      *I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in his word I hope;  
My soul waits for the Lord more than those who watch for the morning,  
More than those who watch for the morning. (Ps 130:5-6)*

What does it mean?              The Psalmist waits with urgency for a sign of God's assurance, like someone awaiting the first light of day – the moment when the darkness will be dissolved in hazy light. It may be slow in coming, but the Psalmist knows that God's redeeming love will come to reassure him, because it is of the nature of God.

Our time of prayer:              We're in a waiting time, God. And worst of all, for some of us it is a time of waiting alone. For some it is a time of waiting for things we fear might happen, for some, a time of waiting for things to get better. Blessed are we when we wait for you, for with you is steadfast love and with you is great power to redeem.
